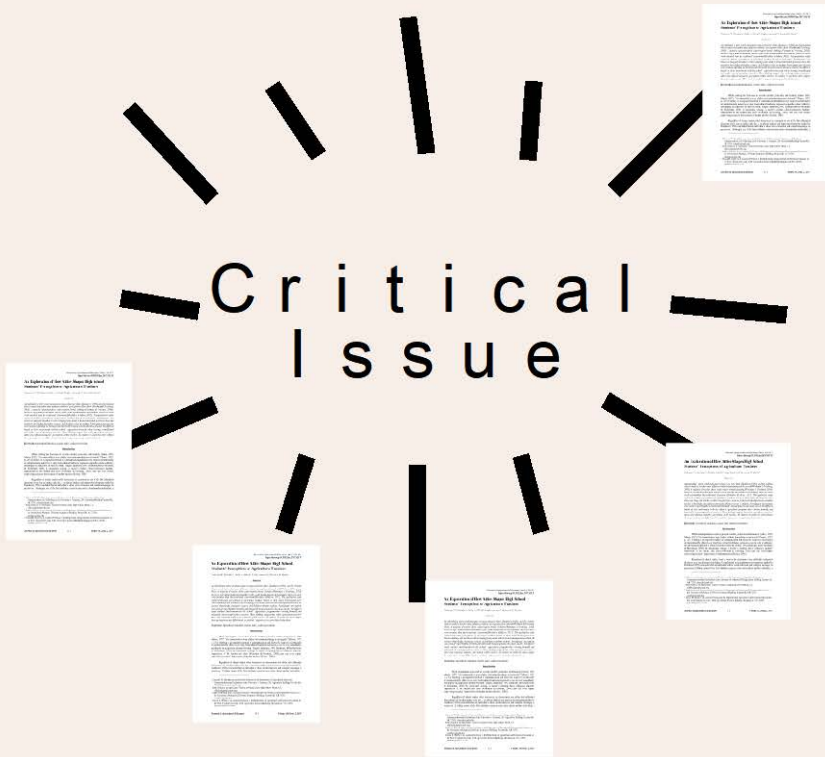

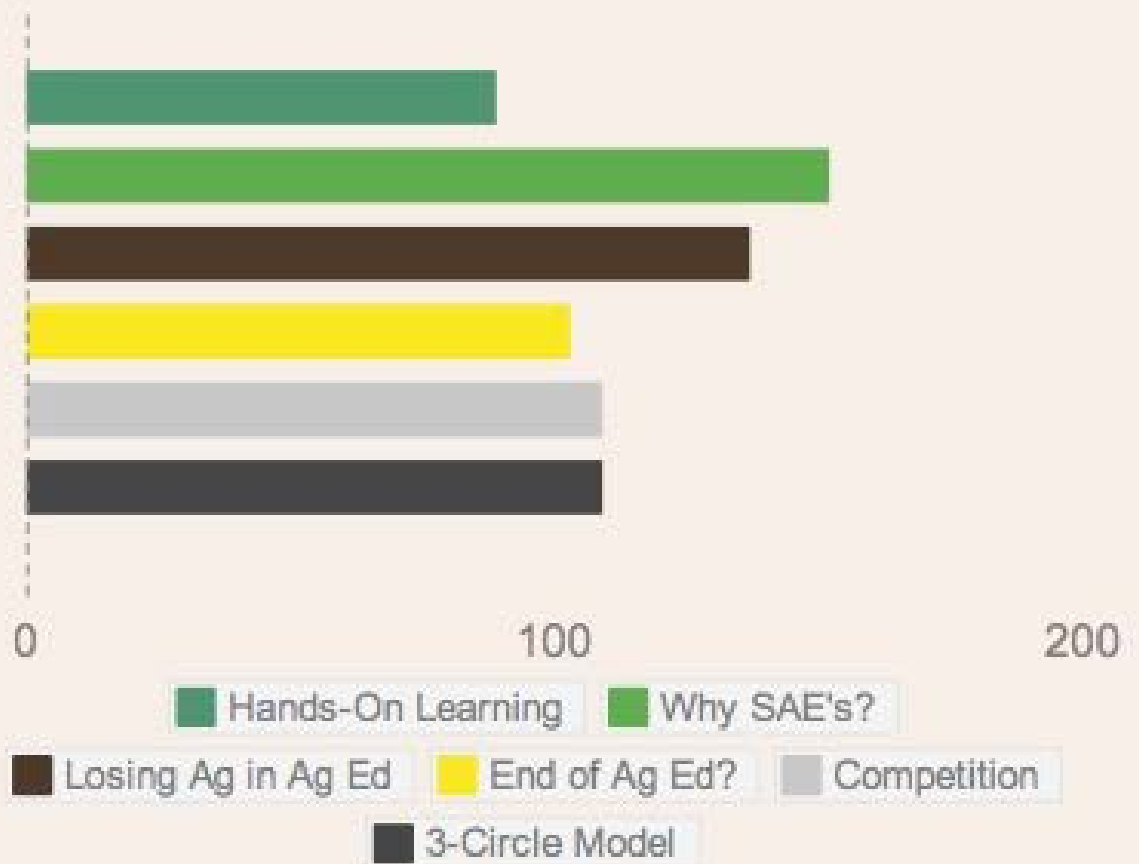
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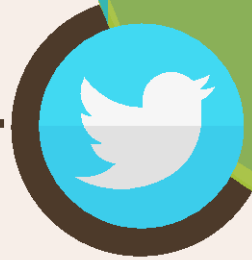
WHAT WE LEARNED

Share this model with other scientists (that is you all!) to be used to increase our impact.



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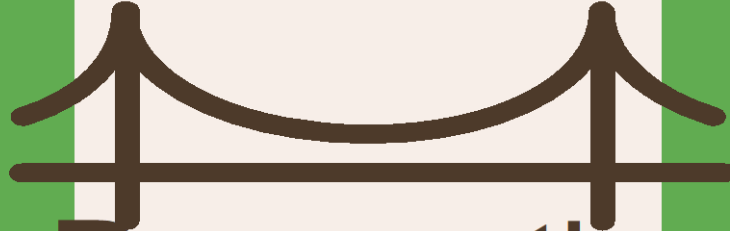
