b. True or False

This exam will consist of questions from the following categories:

a. Identification

- breeds
- coat color and/or color patterns
- tack
- equipment
- tools
- grains/forages
- parasites
- basic anatomy (internal or external)

b. General Knowledge

- vitals
- reproduction
- anatomy
- nutrition
- age
- performance
- events

c. Tie-Breaker questions will be asked at the end of the exam

CONTEST RULES

1. All contestants will take the same exam, regardless of school division. The exam will be offered one time only. This is a broad-based, individual knowledge exam (multiple choice and true/false).
2. Each participating school may enter one competing team. A team shall consist of four (4) members. Each team will compete in their respective division, either the junior (2-year schools) or senior (4- year schools) division.
3. A team shall consist of four (4) members, competing individually. The team score will be the total of all four team members. Schools may enter more than one team, but only one team will be designated prior to the start of the contest as the team competing from each school for team awards.
4. Contestants may compete individually for the 2 year and 4 year top individual, without being part of a team.
5. Each contestant will compete individually with absolutely no conferring during the contest.
6. All decisions of the judges will be final.
7. Time allowance for the exam will be monitored by the judges.
8. No cell phones or electronic devices are allowed.
9. Standard test etiquette will be expected from all participants.
10. Additional questions offered at the end of the exam will be used to break any ties.
