Although the position is a non-tenure appointment, it is eligible for rank promotion to Associate and Full similar to a tenure-track appointment. This position carries a 9-month appointment with the opportunity to teach courses during the summer for additional compensation.

Summary of Duties:

The Teaching Assistant Professor position will have a maximum 24 credit teaching load each academic year (four courses per semester), with a mix of face-to-face and online courses, as needed. Possible teaching assignments for this position include Principles of Microeconomics, Principles of Macroeconomics, Introduction to Agribusiness, Farm Financial Records, Farm Business Management, and Agribusiness Marketing and Management at the undergraduate level. The specific teaching assignment will be determined based on the experience and interests of the successful candidate and the department's needs. In addition to teaching, the Teaching Assistant Professor position will carry a service appointment, including service assignments such as undergraduate program curriculum committee membership, student advising, and club sponsorship.
