- A short scale intercultural competency assessment
  - 14 items (handout)
  - 6 point Likert type scale
- Based on the AAC&U VALUE Rubric ICC



## A.S.K.S. 2 - FORMAT

- 6 subscales
  - Openness
    - Curiosity
      - Communication
        - Empathy
          - Worldview
            - Self-awareness



## CARTAGENA, COLOMBIA

- Daily debriefings and interactions
- Engaged in three days of service projects with the Palenque
- Interactions with different cultural
- Acclimate and adapt to a new environment, language, and cultural norms.








#### **Openness**

 $r = 0.76$   $p = 0.004$ 




#### Communication




#### Worldview

#### **DEMOGRAPHICS**

- Ethnicity
- Nationality (Country of origin)
- Gender
- Colleges at Purdue
- First or More International

- 10 African Americans, 2 Caucasian, and 1 Latina
- All students were from the USA
- 11 females, 2 males
- 4 Colleges represented
  - Agriculture, Health and Human Sciences, Liberal Arts, and Science.
- 9 first time international experience



### **IMPACT**

#### **Statistically Significant**

- Intercultural Openness
- Personal Development (empathy)

#### Pre-assessment

 indicated that the group's openness and comfort with cultural difference and others was above average.

#### Post-assessment

 indicated mean growth across all six subscales and thus overall. That growth was confirmed by the program leaders' observations of and conversations with the participants.
