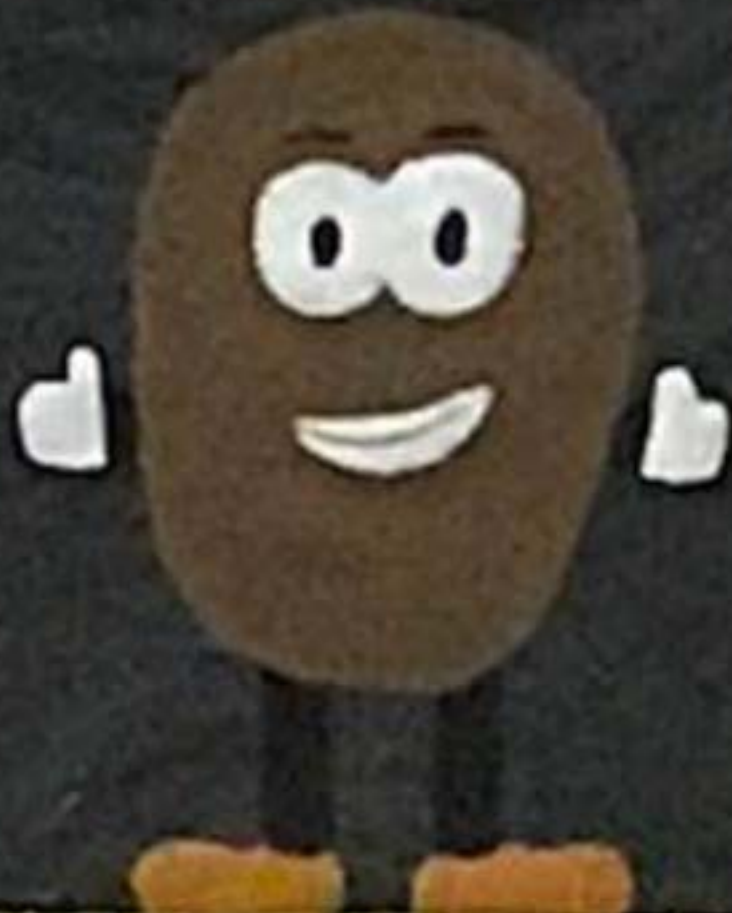
Canonization
