# Determining the Conference Theme

- Invited all faculty & staff in the UWRF
   College of Agriculture, Food and
   Environmental Sciences (CAFES) to
   suggest topics
- Encouraged to tie in the CAFES centennial
- Held meeting to narrow choices
- Invited all faculty & staff to vote on final theme

#### Planning committee

- Invited all CAFES faculty & staff to join
- Final committee included faculty from all 5 departments
- Created a rare opportunity to discuss teaching improvement with colleagues across departments

### Opening Reception Activity

- Wanted to give conference attendees the opportunity to visit various CAFES facilities
- Committee members identified places to feature for various programs

#### Facilitating tours and sessions

- Tours were set up by location, not specific disciplines and most included multiple disciplines
- Oral presentation sessions were organized around topical themes, not specific disciplines
- Facilitators met counterparts from a variety of disciplines during the tours and sessions
