Introduction

The Smith-Hughes Act of 1917, which marked the beginning of the increased growth in agricultural education across the country, is simultaneously celebrating its 100th anniversary. The Smith-Hughes Act provided the funding needed to educate more individuals to teach agriculture in public schools. Consequently, the Department of Agricultural Education was established at The Ohio State University.

Purposes

- 2. To utilize secondary sources such as previously published departmental histories and newsletters.
